The Debtors, through counsel of record undersigned, hereby submit the following Application to employ John Francomano, Esq., ("Francomano") and Francomano & Karpook, P.A. (the "Firm") pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 327(a), and Rule 2014 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, *nunc pro tunc*, to the filing of these bankruptcy cases:

On or about April 1, 2005, the Arizona Corporation Commission caused to be filed, in the Superior Court in and for the State of Arizona, a Verified Complaint in the above-captioned matter against numerous individual defendants and entities, seeking the appointment of a Receiver over the named Defendants.

On April 5, 2005, this Court issued its Order appointing James C. Sell Receiver for the approximately 30 entities named in the Receivership complaint.

1 Thereafter, the Receiver took possession of the Receivership Assets. In connection
2 therewith, the Receiver required the services of various professionals – including Francomano &
3 Karpook, to assist as Local Counsel for the Debtor in Baltimore, Maryland.

4 Subsequently, after notice and hearing, the Court on April 14, 2005 issued its Order
5 approving the Stipulation Regarding Order Appointing Conservator, in which the title of James C.
6 Sell was changed from Receiver to Conservator (hereinafter, the “Conservatorship Order”). The
7 rights and obligations of the Conservator remained identical to those of the Receiver.

8 Pursuant to an Order entered in the State Court proceeding on October 25, 2005, that
9 Court authorized the filing of Bankruptcy for three Conservatorship Entities: Mathon Fund I,
10 LLC, Mathon Fund, LLC and W.S.F. – World Sports Fans, LLC.

11 In compliance therewith, these Bankruptcy Cases were commenced on November 13,
12 2005. Included within the Schedules filed in connection with the Mathon Fund I, Case, was real
13 property belonging to the Debtors and located in Baltimore, Maryland (the “Property”).

14 Thereafter, the Firm continued to provide its services to the Receivership Estate, which
15 necessarily included his also providing such services to the Debtors.

16 Although the Debtors sought the employment of various professionals, through an
17 oversight due in part to the fact that the Firm had been retained by the Receivership Estate, the
18 Debtors failed to seek such appointment for Francomano or the Firm.

19 On January 12, 2006, this Court entered an Order allowing for the Joint Administration of
20 the above referenced bankruptcy estates. This Motion is filed in the Mathon Fund LLC jointly
21 administered case in accordance with the Court’s prior Joint Administration Order.

22 Neither Francomano nor the Firm has performed any other services for the Debtors other
23 than relating to acting as Local Counsel in Maryland.

24 The Debtors now require the services of the Firm to act as Special Counsel in Maryland.

25 Consequently, the Debtors now seek to employ the Firm, *nunc pro tunc*, to
26 commencement of the Bankruptcy Cases.

27 Other than in regard to their aforementioned services, neither Francomano nor the Firm
28 are a creditor of these Debtors Estates, nor do they hold or represent any interest adverse to the

1 Debtors Estates, as set forth in Francomano's Affidavit in Support of this Application annexed
2 hereto as Exhibit "A."

3 Francomano and the Firm will charge their normal hourly rates for this engagement, plus
4 expenses. Such rates are as follows:

5 Partner:	\$250.00
6 Associate	\$250.00
7 Administrative	\$ N/A

8 Accordingly, Francomano and the Firm satisfy the statutory requirements to serve as a
9 professional pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 327.

10 WHEREFORE, the Debtors request that they be authorized to employ and appoint Mr.
11 Francomano and the Firm, *nunc pro tunc*, to the commencement of these Bankruptcy Cases .




